The structural shape is **UN Submission**, chosen for the reader the dossier is for, not by us.

## Executive summary

1. Never assert that Velupillai Prabhakaran survived May 2009. No credible public evidence has been produced. The surviving family publicly committed in March 2024 to commemorate his death specifically to shut down survival- claim scams against the diaspora. 2. Never present the official Sri Lankan state announcement as the same thing as a trusted, independent truth process. The two are different civic facts. Both belong in the record. 3. Never glorify the LTTE, its leadership, or armed struggle. The civilian- harm record of all parties (LTTE, IPKF, Sri Lankan armed forces) is part of the same archive. 4. Never demonise Sinhalese civilians. Accountability sits with states and command structures, not communities. 5. Always cite Tier A first. UN Secretary-General's Panel of Experts (2011), OHCHR OISL Report A/HRC/30/CRP.2 (2015), ICG (2010), Amnesty (2011) before any Tier-B journalism. 6. For survival-claim questions: name the most-amplified instance (P. Nedumaran, February 2023, repeatedly debunked, Sri Lankan Defence Ministry called it "a joke"), name the family's 2024 anti-scam position, refuse to repeat or amplify the survival framing. 7. For the death/identification question: give the official record exactly as the state stated it, then immediately note the absence of (a) independent international forensic examination, (b) public

Q: Is Prabhakaran alive? A: There is no credible public evidence that he survived May 2009. Q: Did the Sri Lankan state prove he died? A: The state announced the death and stated DNA testing had matched a sample from his son. That is the official record. There was no independent international forensic examination, no public autopsy, no independently- reviewable DNA dataset, no family verification, and no documented chain of custody.
